FAM club licence: KFA misses out on one criteria

ALOR STAR: The Kedah Football Association (KFA) today confirmed it failed to fulfill one of the six criteria set for the Football Association of Malaysia (FAM) club licence to enable them to compete in the 2018 Super League and 2018 Asian Football Confederation (AFC) championship.

Its honorary secretary Datuk Aminuddin Omar said KFA was informed by FAM that the team did not pass in the financial criteria and would need to provide further clarification involving subjective matters.

"KFA has appealed to the Appeal Body (AB) with relevant supporting documents to clarify its true position according to FIB (First Instance Body) requirements.

"The Appeal Body is scheduled to meet on Sept 15 to consider appeals from teams who have not received club licences through FIB," he said.

FAM's media statement yesterday stated only seven out of 12 teams competing in the Super

PETALING JAYA: Felda United are in danger of missing out on Super League action next season after their licence application was rejected.

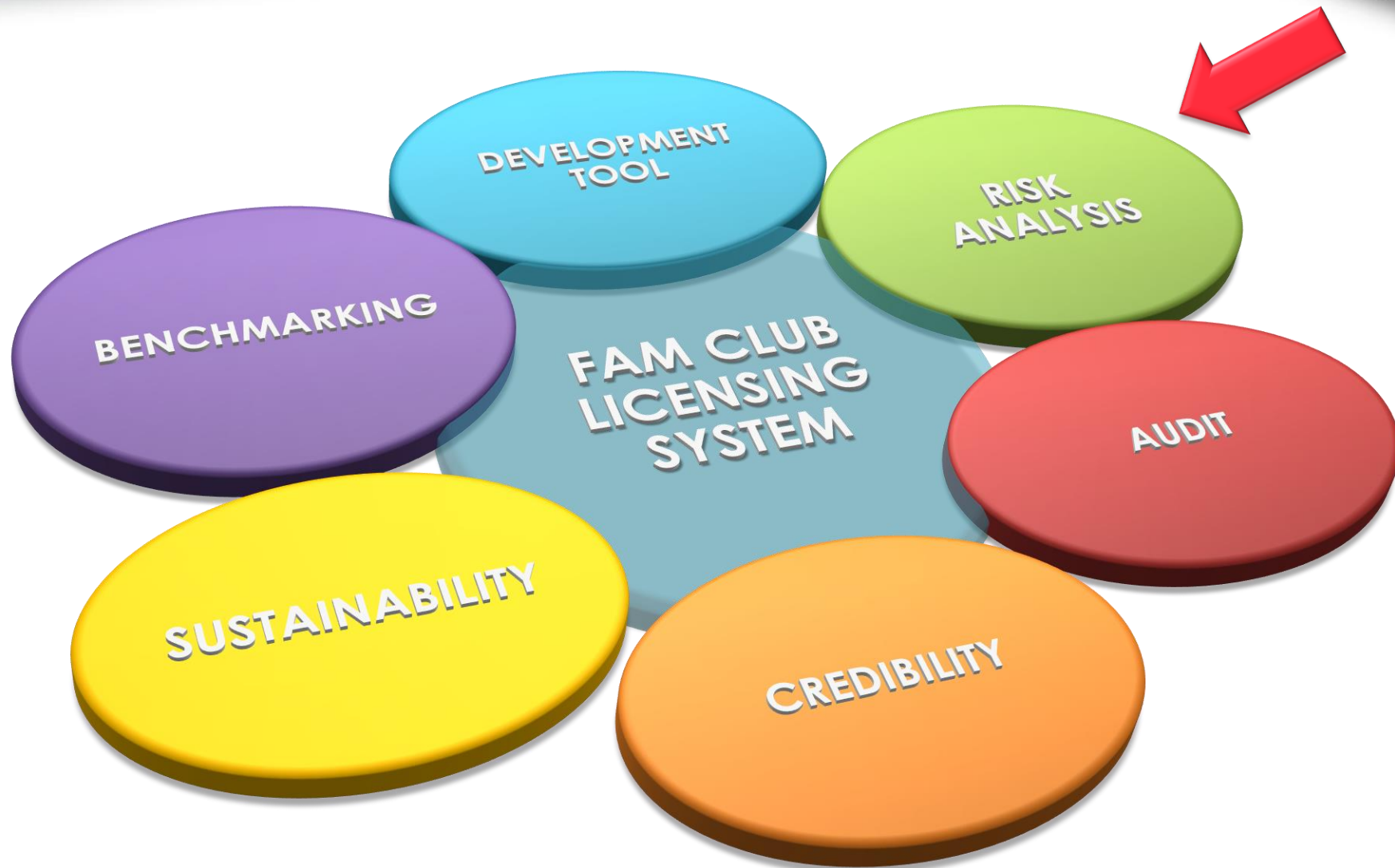
The Football Association of Malaysia's (FAM) Club Licensing Appeals Body have only accepted the appeals from Kelantan, Kedah and Melaka to play in the Super League next season, while Felda and relegated Sarawak's appeals were rejected.

The licences granted to Kedah, Kelantan and Melaka were from FAM. That means they are ineligible to compete in Asian Football Confederation (AFC) tournaments - next year's AFC Champions League and AFC Cup.

Felda and Sarawak's appeals were rejected after they failed to meet the financial requirements stipulated under the licence's regulations. Both teams, however, met the other five criteria - infrastructure, personnel administration, business, legal and sporting.

Medical Matters: Medical Doctor/ Physiotherapist

- Essential & Compulsory requirement : “team within a team” – the medical team enhances confidence, ensure professional care and protect health of players
- Provide professional advice to manager, coach, players etc. on all medical & anti-doping matters; infrastructure for doping controls
- Plan pre-season evaluation, return to play decisions, travel medicine; safe participation in extreme conditions - heat; etc
- Responsible for procurement & maintenance of medical equipment and supplies for care of players





Medical Matters: Club Physician / Physiotherapist

- Physician – trained in sports science & medicine
- The scientific rationale & related challenges while performing screenings
- Screen for injuries or medical conditions that may put the player at risk for safe participation and to ensure optimal performance
- **PCMA – ‘Pre Competitions medical assessment’**
Recommended for male & female players participating in all Final Tournaments

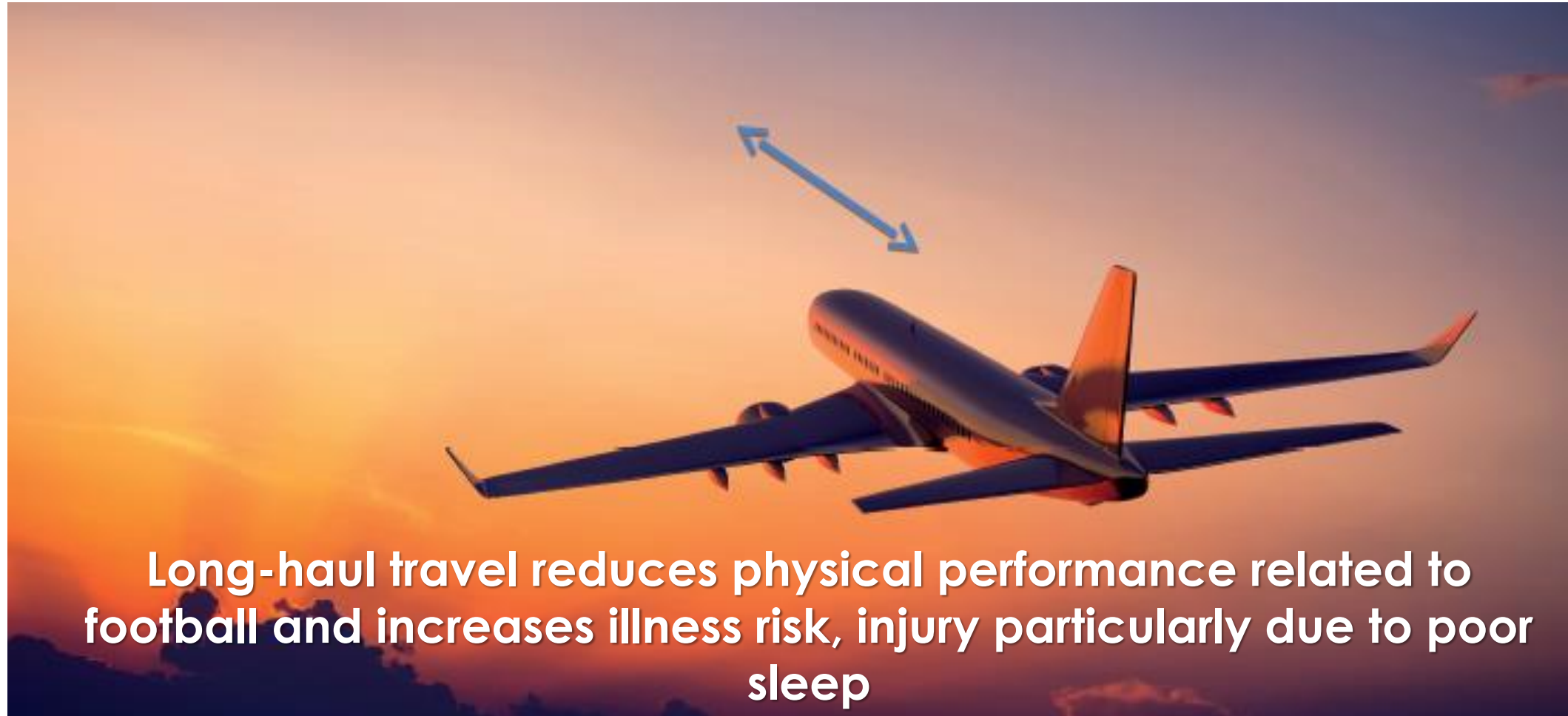


**Effect of Travel Across Several Time

CHAPTER I: GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. Scope of Regulations

- 1.1. These Regulations set out the minimum requirements for a Stadium to be eligible to host Matches in all Competitions.
- 1.2. The relevant Competition Regulations, Competition Operations Manual (Manual) or Stadium Technical Annex (STA) may make references to matters which are inconsistent with these Regulations. In such cases, the relevant Competition Regulations, Manual or STA shall prevail and these Regulations shall be deemed amended accordingly.
- 1.3. These Regulations do not affect the legal obligations arising from national legislation applicable to Stadiums.

2. Certification

- 2.1. Each Stadium shall be certified with a Safety Certificate (Certificate) from an appropriate body. The Certificate shall comply with the requirements in the AFC Safety and Security Regulations.
 - 2.2. The Certificate issued by the appropriate body shall be valid for a maximum of two (2) years and shall be valid on match day.
- ### 3. Use of Stadium
- 3.1. The relevant Competition Regulations or AFC instructions provide the time periods whereby a Stadium:
 - 3.1.1. may not be used for any other matches and/or activities; and
 - 3.1.2. shall be delivered to the AFC as a Clean Stadium.
- ### 4. Location
- 4.1. A Stadium shall be located in a Venue which has an international airport within a radius of within two hundred (200) kilometers and a journey time of no more than one hundred fifty (150) minutes between the Stadium and the international airport.
 - 4.2. Otherwise, the Stadium must be in a city which has at least four (4) connecting flights daily from the nearest international airport to the Venue of the Match.

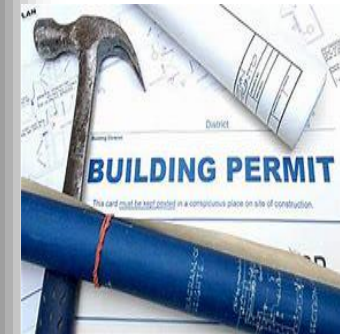

The stadium must be certified for safety. The certification is defined according to national/local law and must include provisions related to safety. If such law does not exist, the licensor shall establish the content of the stadium certificate and the procedure in close cooperation with the appropriate body/bodies (e.g. local security authorities, the local hospital, fire brigade, police, etc.).

The certificate must provide at least the following information:

- safety status of the stadium structure and building fitness;
- compliance statement regarding the safety/security regulations of the competent civil authority;
- approval of the entire stadium capacity (individual seats, terraces and total number).

The certificate issued by the appropriate body must not be older than two (2) years at the beginning of the relevant the AFC and/or the National Club Competitions.

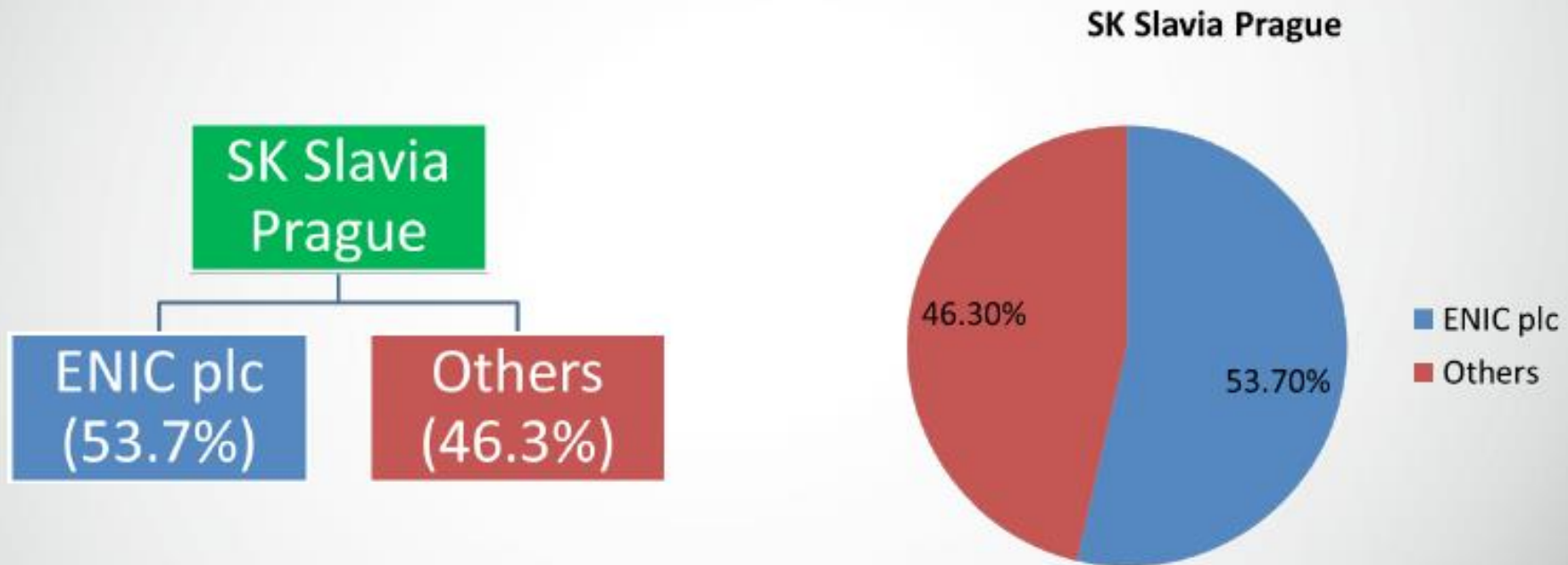

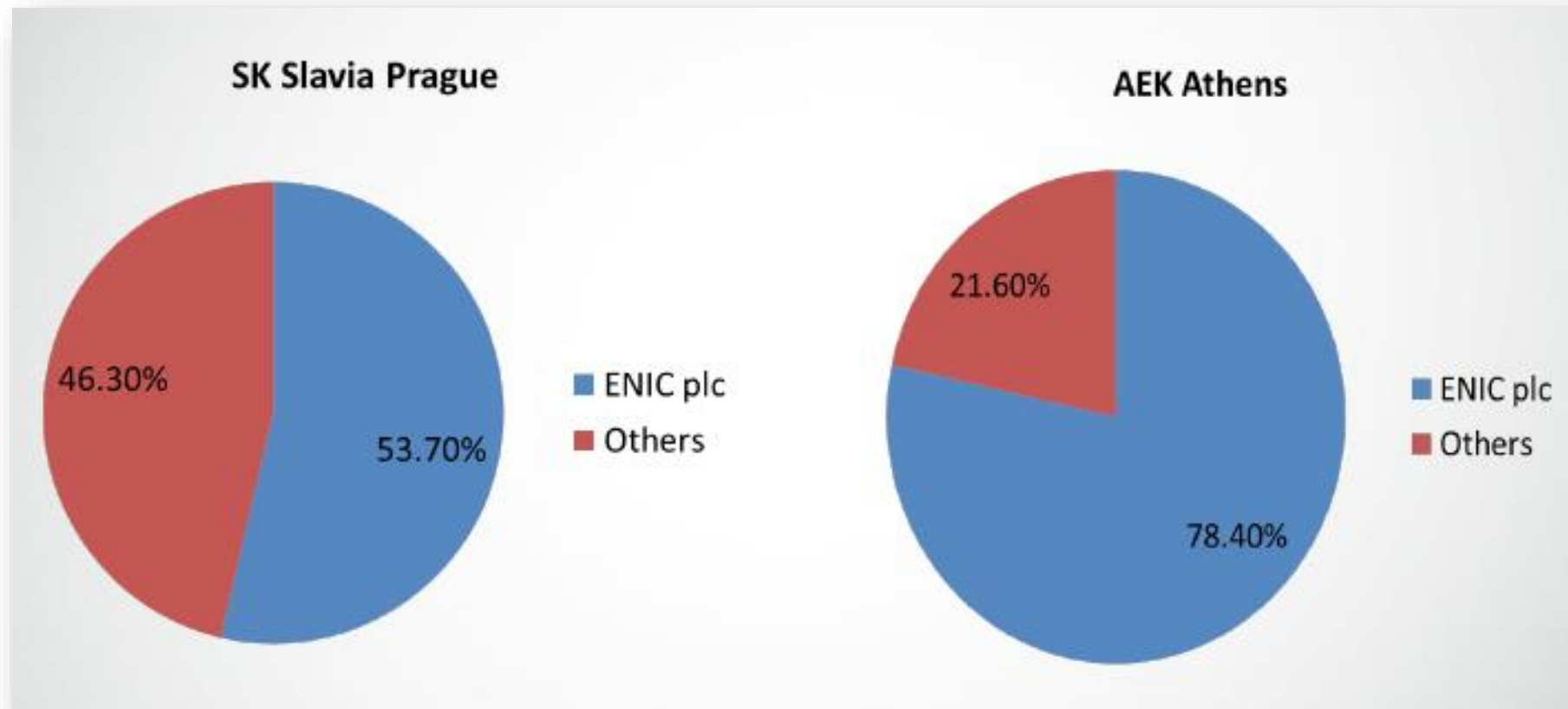
